



Earthquake/Disaster Procedures and Release Form

1. All students will be kept at or close to the school in a safe place and released only to persons listed on this and the Emergency & Identification forms.
2. When parents arrive at school to pick up their children:
 - Please do not park cars where they may block emergency vehicles access.
 - Parents must sign-out with teachers before students are released. Individuals other than parents will be required to show identification before students will be released.
 - If possible, spend some extra time at the school to help teachers take care of the students.
3. If your child is on a field trip:
 - The children will be kept together with their driver until they can be safely returned to school.
 - Children will only be released to parents or persons listed on this and/or other Emergency & Identification Forms.
4. Listen to the radio for up-to date-information. Radio Station 1610 AM broadcasts taped messaged 24 hours a day regarding civil disturbances, road closures, and other pertinent information.
